The Council is the Local Government Authority for the Woorabinda Aboriginal Shire area and the Trustee of the Woorabinda Deed of Grant in Trust (DOGIT). As the Local Government Authority, Council as duly elected representatives of the community, through local decision making has the responsibility of deciding what is in the best interest of the community, advancing a thriving community.
It is considered that approving (with conditions) the Material Change of Use to enable Residential Use of Rural land and the associated Reconfiguring of lot to increase future residential development on Green Street, Woorabinda is of benefit



to, representative of the aspirations and advancing housing delivery for the Woorabinda community.

- 1. Council as the Local Government Authority and Trustee of the DOGIT resolves to approve (subject to conditions):
 - a. The Development Application lodged with Council for: i.Preliminary Approval for Material Change of Use to vary the effect of the planning Scheme for use rights in accordance with the Township Zone to enable Residential Use (Dual Occupancy & Dwelling House) of Rural land located on Green Street, Woorabinda (part of lot 137 SP268500) and Rural land located on Munns Drive, Woorabinda (part of lot 135 SP316497); and
 - ii. Development Permit for staged Reconfiguring of lot 137 SP268500 into 22 lots and balance Lot plus road (via extension of existing Green Street), Woorabinda.
- 2. Council as the Local Government Authority and Trustee of the DOGIT resolves to
 - a. surrender an area of land for the purpose of dedicating it as public roads (Green Street and unnamed/new road) as depicted on plan 0715-008 dated 29/03/2022 in terms of section 94 of the Land Act 1994.
 - apply to the Minister responsible for administering the Land
 1994 for the surrender of part of the DOGIT in terms of Section
 of the Land Act 1994 for public road purposes.
 - c. acknowledge the land administration actions incidental to, and necessary, to facilitate lodgement and registration of the survey plan.
