

Community Grant Program Information Guide 2023/24



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Overview

Woorabinda Aboriginal Shire Council Community Grant Program is designed to support local organisations and/or groups located in Woorabinda to deliver events and activities to achieve the Strategic Goal for 'A vibrant community that is safe, healthy, educated and proud of their culture and traditions and embraces diversity.

The Community Grants can assist individuals to advance in their chosen sporting activity, micro business development in the creative arts sector and community groups to increase cohesion and wellbeing in the community.

Grant Program Objectives

The overarching objective of the Community Grants Programs is to increase community participation to:

- Make a positive contribution toward enhancing community wellbeing.
- Respond to community issues and trends by providing opportunities for social inclusion through community events and activity
- Build social connections through the delivery of activities in places and spaces within Woorabinda.
- Deliver safe and socially responsible events and activities to reduce risk of harm in the community.
- Increase participation for individuals and groups to advance in an event and/or activity to nurture talent for the future.

General Eligibility Criteria

Community Groups and organisation:

- Must be based within Woorabinda and be able to demonstrate that the project, program and/or activity will directly benefit Woorabinda Residents
- Should be an incorporated 'not for profit' organisation or a company limited by guarantee that is registered with Australian Charities and Not-For-Profits Commission.
- Must have relevant insurance cover including public liability or other coverage suitable for the activity to be undertaken.

Individual visual/performance artists and sport representatives:

Sponsored by an organisation or affiliated sporting group.

 Provision of quotes and tax invoice from organisations to supply goods and/or services. This includes hire of equipment and facilities.

Who cannot Apply

- · Commercial organisations
- Government agencies
- Political groups

Events, Projects, Program and/or Activities

- The grants program aims to provide limited financial assistance in relation to the development and delivery of events, programs, project and/or activities, and not intended to be relied upon as a primary source of funding.
- Grants will not be provided for events, projects, programs and/or activities which are to be undertaken for the sole purpose of profit generation.
- Council encourages co-funding from other external funding sources and reserves the right to part fund a grant application.
- Events, projects, programs and/or activities that have commenced prior to the receipt of Council funding are ineligible.
- In the event that the funded event does not occur, or the activity or program which
 was the subject of the funding is not delivered, the grant recipient will be required to
 repay the full amount of the Council funding awarded.

Eligibility Conditions

In addition to the general eligibility criteria, the following eligibility conditions apply to all community grants.

- Environmental projects must be approved prior to submitting an application and they
 must be undertaken within Woorabinda Aboriginal Shire Council boundary.
 Environmental project on areas leased or owned by other individuals, groups or
 organisations may be considered, however, wider community benefit must be
 demonstrated.
- Equipment purchases are eligible when:
 - The equipment relates to the delivery of specific community capacity building initiative that demonstrated wider community benefit
 - The equipment purchase is integral to the sustainability of the organisation as reflect in the applicants strategic plan. (evidence of this needs to be provided)

- Where appropriate, arts and cultural projects should be in collaboration with Woorabinda's Art & Cultural Program to identify opportunities for increased collaboration and partnering to benefit the community.
- Projects must not clash with or adversely affect existing community events, including Council events.
- Significant celebratory events, such as milestone anniversaries for community organisation will be eligible for a grant category if wider community benefit is demonstrated.
- Applicants must be located in Woorabinda Aboriginal Shire Council boundaries at the time of application
- A maximum of two (2) grants per applicant may be awarded in any financial calendar year.

Specific Exclusions

- Ongoing salaries/wages, administrative and operating costs
- Payment of debt
- Routine emergency maintenance/repairs of facilities
- Purchase of work uniforms and workplace, health and safety equipment and attire
- Purchase of capital items such as office equipment, computers and machinery
- Purchase of alcoholic beverages
- Travel related expenses (excluding Creative Arts Grants & Sport & Recreation)
- Judging fees
- Training courses such as first aid and/or security.
